

THE BIBLICAL FEASTS MASTER SCRIPTURE SHEET

“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.” — Psalm 119:105

I. THE FOUNDATIONAL MANDATE

- **Leviticus 23:1-44** — The complete, chronological blueprint of all the appointments of the Lord.
 - **Colossians 2:16-17** — The New Testament reality: the feasts are a shadow of things to come, but the body is of Christ.
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II. THE SPRING FEASTS

The Feast of Unleavened Bread

- **Exodus 12:15-20** — The original commandment to remove leaven and eat unleavened bread for seven days.
- **Exodus 13:3-10** — Memorializing the hasty midnight flight from Egypt and the house of bondage.
- **1 Corinthians 5:7-8** — The Christian application: purging out the old leaven of malice to walk in sincerity and truth.
- **Luke 22:19** — Jesus breaks the unleavened bread, declaring it to be His body broken for us.

The Feast of Firstfruits

- **Leviticus 23:9-14** — The standard for bringing the early spring barley sheaf to the priest to be waved.
 - **1 Corinthians 15:20-23** — Christ is risen from the dead and has become the firstfruits of them that slept.
 - **John 12:24** — The principle of the seed falling into the ground and dying to bring forth much fruit.
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III. THE SUMMER HARVEST APPOINTMENT

Pentecost / The Feast of Weeks

- **Leviticus 23:15-22** — The commandment to count 50 days from Firstfruits and offer two leavened wave loaves.
 - **Exodus 19:1-25 & 20:1-26** — The historical giving of the Law on stone tablets at Mount Sinai at this exact seasonal time.
 - **Acts 2:1-4** — Pentecost fully comes: the outpouring of the Holy Ghost with cloven tongues of fire.
 - **2 Corinthians 3:3** — The law is no longer written on stone, but on the fleshy tables of the heart by the Spirit of God.
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IV. THE FALL FEASTS

Yom Teruah / The Feast of Trumpets

- **Leviticus 23:23-25** — The mandate for a sabbath rest and a memorial of the blowing of trumpets.
- **1 Thessalonians 4:16-18** — The Lord descending with a shout, the voice of the archangel, and the trump of God.
- **1 Corinthians 15:51-52** — The transformation of the saints in the twinkling of an eye at the last trump.
- **Luke 12:35-36** — Staying alert with your loins girded and your lights burning, waiting for the Lord's return.

Yom Kippur / The Day of Atonement

- **Leviticus 23:26-32** — The high sabbath command to fast, rest from all labor, and afflict your souls.
- **Leviticus 16:1-34** — The ancient temple ritual of the high priest entering the veil and selecting the scapegoat.
- **Isaiah 53:4-6** — The prophetic picture of Christ bearing our griefs, being wounded for our transgressions, and acting as our scapegoat.

- **Hebrews 9:11-12 & Hebrews 10:19-22** — Christ entering the heavenly holy place by His own blood, tearing the veil, and giving us boldness to enter.
- **Micah 7:19** — God subduing our iniquities and casting our sins into the depths of the sea.

Sukkot / The Feast of Tabernacles

- **Leviticus 23:33-43** — The instruction to live in temporary booths for seven days and rejoice with the branches of beautiful trees.
- **Exodus 25:8-9** — God commanding Moses to build the wilderness Tabernacle so He could dwell in the midst of His people.
- **John 1:14** — The Word was made flesh and tabernacled (*dwelt*) among us, full of grace and truth.
- **John 7:37-38** — Jesus standing up on the last great day of the water ceremony to offer rivers of living water.
- **Zechariah 14:16-19** — The prophetic future: all nations gathering in Jerusalem during the Millennial Kingdom to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.

Shemini Atzeret / The Eighth Day

- **Leviticus 23:36** — The command for a distinct, separate solemn assembly on the eighth day.
- **Revelation 21:1-7** — The new heaven, the new earth, and the New Jerusalem where the tabernacle of God is permanently with men.
- **Revelation 22:1-5** — The throne of God and the Lamb providing eternal light, where there is no more night.
